SOURCE OF ENVIRONMENTAL FUND

SOURCE OF FUNDS

Money provided from time to time by the Government

Donations and contributions received from within or outside Malaysia

Cess imposed or collected in accordance with section 36A

Moneys paid or received in accordance with section 36D from:

- exploration, extraction, refining, production, bulk movement, distribution or storage, of oil;
- production, bulk movement, distribution or storage, of environmentally hazardous substances; or
- bulk movement or storage, of waste





SCHEDULED WASTE CESS

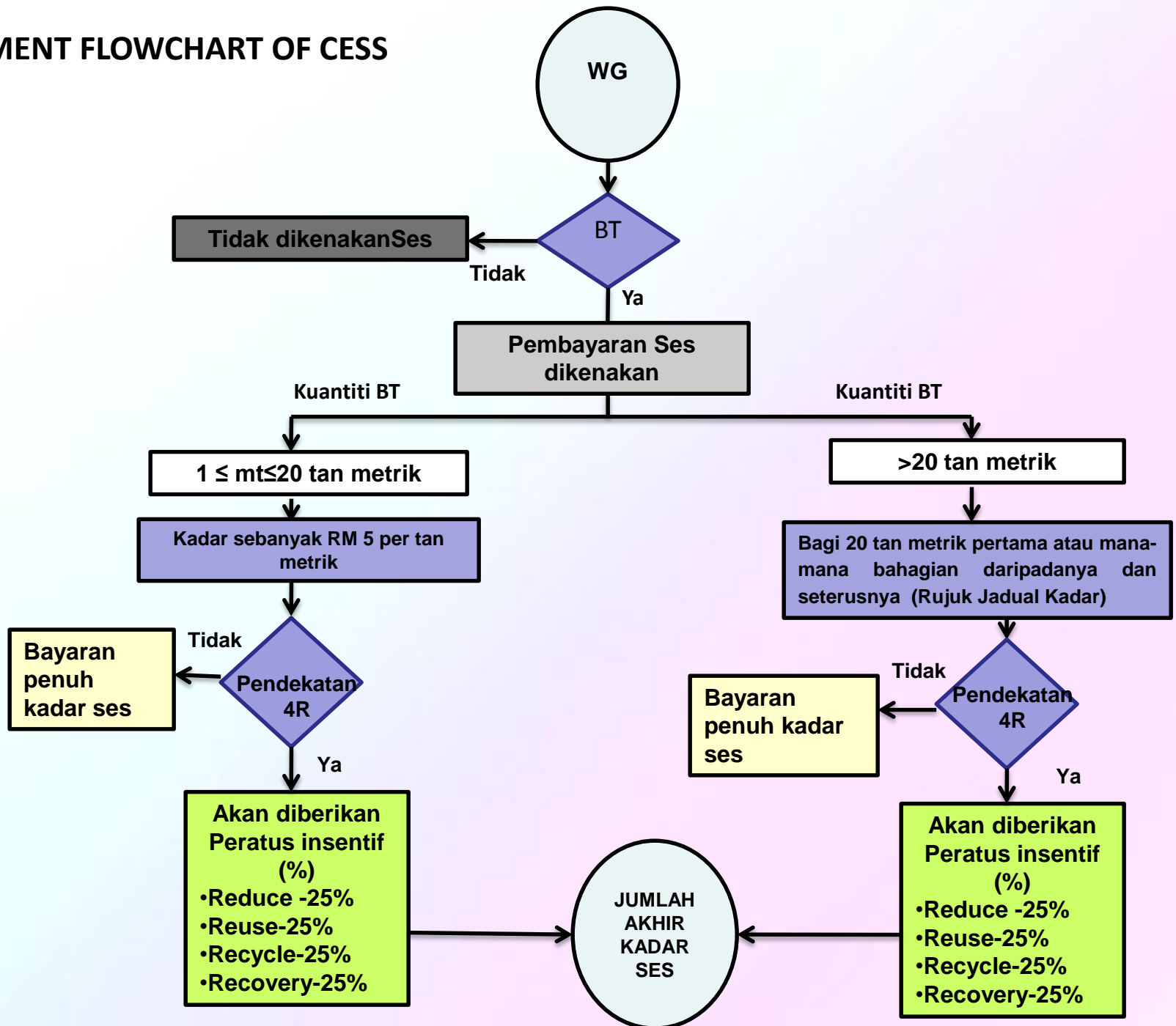


The main intentions of imposing scheduled waste cess is to encourage minimization/reduction of scheduled waste generation and for Cess Fund to be used for research to improve the management of scheduled waste in the country.

To reduce scheduled waste Cess amount, each waste generator would be more careful in segregating scheduled waste from other wastes

The formulation of hazardous waste cess system consists of the following features:

- i. Designed with a framework that would encouraged waste minimization and resource recovery;
- i. Designed for automated invoicing and online payment records

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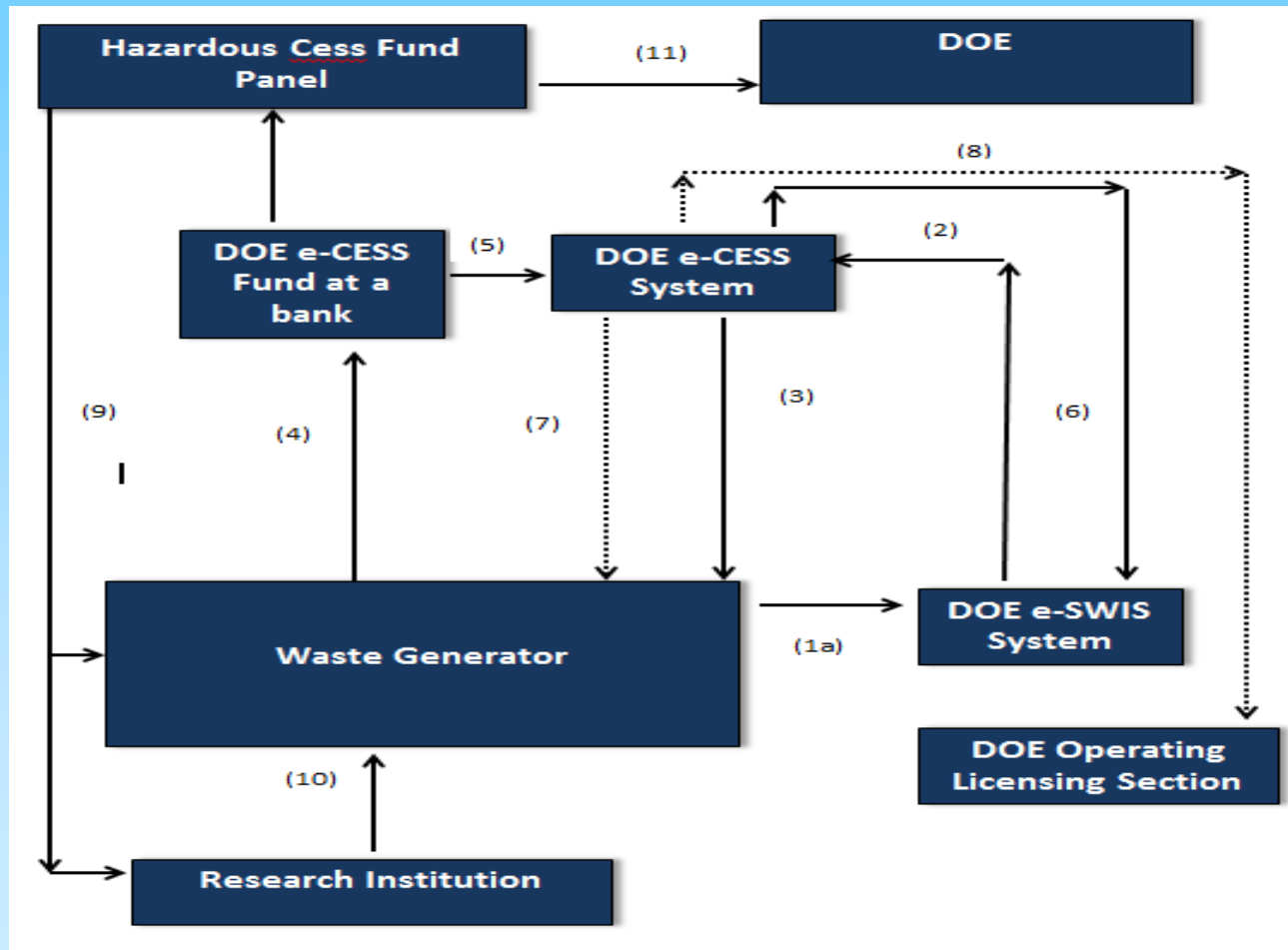

The activities involved in the framework

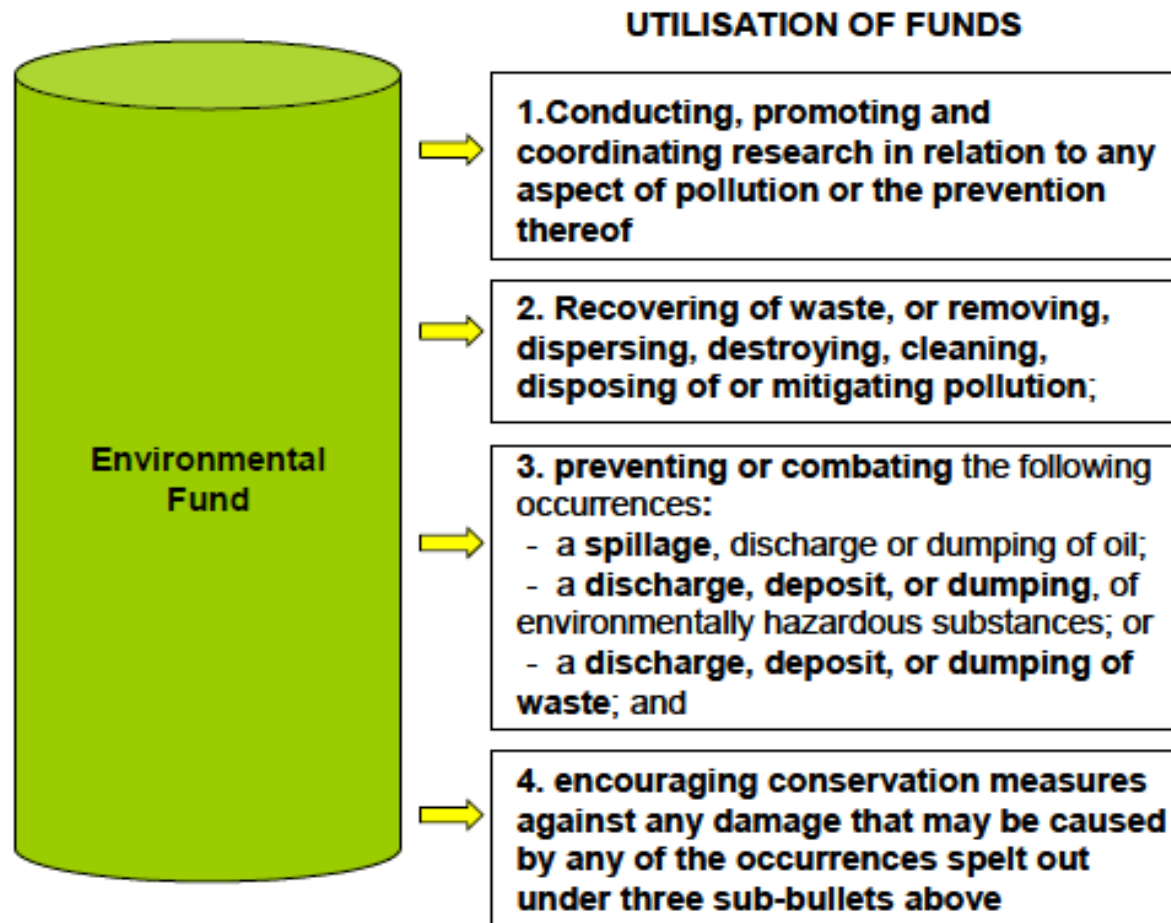
1. a) Reporting of scheduled waste quantities via notification
b) Reporting of scheduled waste reduction
2. Reporting of scheduled waste quantities and qualities liable to cess
3. Cess invoicing based on scheduled waste quantities and qualities and overdues
4. Cess payment into Co X account at scheduled waste cess fund

5. Co X Cess payment status
6. Co X Cess payment status
7. Payment lapse reminder or warning or fines
8. Operating license withheld until all Cess payment cleared
9. Cess fund disbursed for scheduled waste waste R&D

10. R&D findings disseminated

11. Cess fund disbursed for schedule waste management infra improvement and hazardous waste awareness campaign
